From 2016 till now;

All patients that I've done HSCT for them, nearly 50 patients, Including;

15 multiple myeloma with average ages 60 years old /Antilogous BMT 10 acute leukemia (ALL,,, AML) with different subtypes of AML and ages between 20 to 55 years old/allogenic BMT with siblings and related and unrelated donors,

Most of them now alive with mild to moderate GVHD, 2 expired, and others live with severe chronic GVHD

One male CML patient/53 years old, his donor was his full match 45 years old sister (expired,, due to severe GVHD and sepsis)

One patient with non-seminoma germ cell tumor, refractory to all protocol chemotherapy for GCT/Autologous HSCT

About 10 patients with major thalassemia/allogenic BMT

About 10 patients with relapsed NHL(DLBL,,,, FL,,, mantle,, and,,) /Autologous BMT

One male patient(dentit) 40y/o with Hodgkins lymphoma(he was my colleague, unfortunately expired
